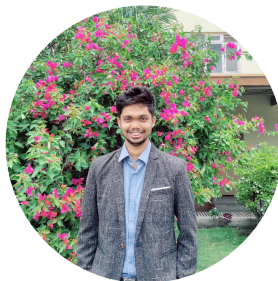

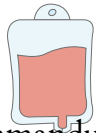

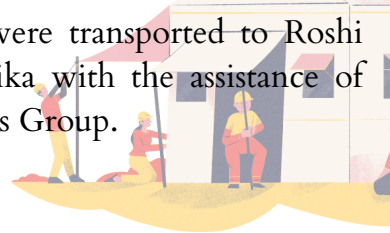
Relief Drive in Roshi Rural Municipality

The initiative aimed to clean the park, raise public awareness and encourage participation.



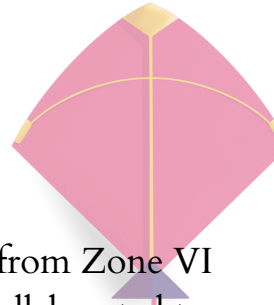
Relief Drive in Konjyosom Rural Municipality

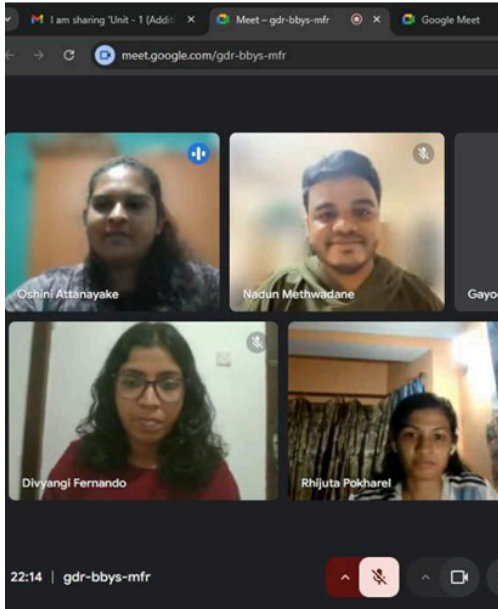
World Heart Day 2024

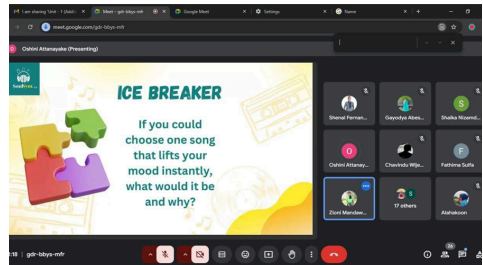


**Joint general meeting with the Rotaract club of

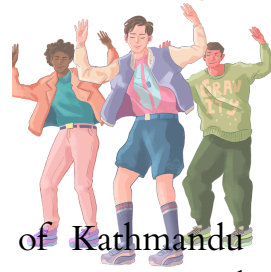

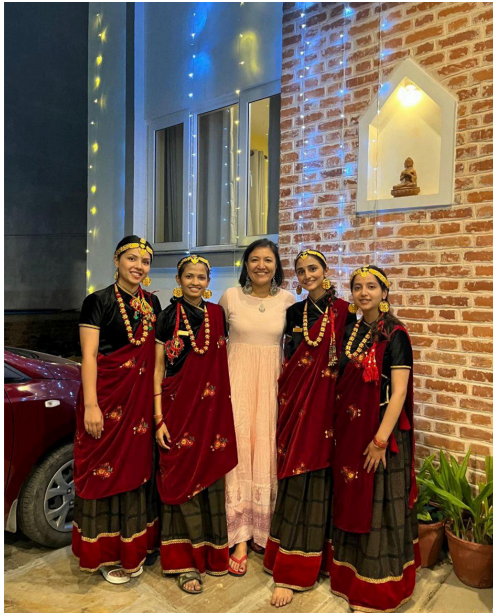




Deusi Bhailo Programme

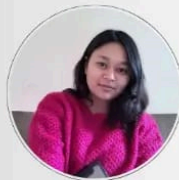
